SUBJECT: Mid-month post adjustment classification memo for May 2019

1. I am pleased to send you the post adjustment multipliers for May 2019. Note that only duty stations with changes in post adjustment multipliers as compared to the previous memo ICSCPADJ-0519-01 are listed.

Group I Duty Stations

2. Based on the results of the most recent cost-of-living survey for group I duty stations, the revised post adjustment multiplier listed in Table 1 is applicable effective 1 May 2019.

Table 1. Revised post adjustment multiplier as a result of cost-of-living survey – May 2019

3. Based on the results of the most recent cost-of-living survey for group I duty stations, the revised applicable rental subsidy thresholds effective 1 May 2019, are listed in Table 2 below.
