SUBJECT: Mid-month post adjustment classification memo for June 2019

1. I am pleased to send you the post adjustment multipliers for June 2019. Note that only duty stations with changes in post adjustment multipliers as compared to the previous memo ICSCPADJ-0619-01 are listed.

Group I Duty Stations

2. Based on the results of the most recent cost-of-living surveys for group I duty stations, the revised post adjustment multipliers listed in Table 1 are applicable effective 1 June 2019.

Table 1. Revised post adjustment multiplier as a result of cost-of-living survey – June 2019

3. Based on the results of the most recent cost-of-living surveys for group I duty stations, the revised applicable rental subsidy thresholds listed in Table 2 below, are effective 1 June 2019.

Group II duty stations

4. The post adjustment multipliers based on the results of the most recent cost-of-living surveys for group II duty stations listed in Table 3 below, are effective 1 June 2019.

5. Cost-of-living survey results did not trigger a change in multiplier for **Bolivia, British Virgin Islands, Guyana and Lesotho**.

6. The post adjustment multiplier result of **Sao Tome and Principe** that was announced on Post adjustment classification (PAC) memo of 31 May 2019, (Ref#: ICSC-PADJ-0619-01) has been revised. Consequently, cost-of-living survey results did not trigger a change in multiplier for **Sao Tome and Principe**.

7. The waiver of the 40 per cent of rent limit on rental subsidies **is no longer applicable** for **Guyana and Serbia** effective 1 June 2019.

8. The waiver of the 40 per cent of rent limit on rental subsidies **is applicable** for **Bolivia, British Virgin Islands, Gabon and Lesotho** effective 1 June 2019.

9. Based on the most recent cost-of-living survey results, the revised applicable rental subsidy thresholds listed in Table 4 below, are effective 1 June 2019.
