SUBJECT: Post adjustment classification memo for August 2020

1. I am pleased to send you the post adjustment multipliers for August 2020. <u>Note that only duty stations with changes in post adjustment multipliers as compared to the previous memo ICSC-PADJ-0820-01, dated 30 July 2020, are listed.</u>

Group I duty stations

2. The post adjustment multipliers, applicable to group I duty stations, as a result of the operation of the 0.5 per cent rule under conditions of currency depreciation/appreciation relative to the U.S. dollar, with effect from 1 August 2020, are given in Table 1.

3. In accordance with the provisions of ICSC/CIRC/GEN/06/2020, five duty stations were eligible for the special measure: Bulgaria, Croatia, Hungary, Poland and Romania. However, the measure was not applied to any of the duty stations, because the post adjustment multipliers derived from using the special measure turned out to be lower than those based on the 0.5 per cent rule.

Group II duty stations

4. Based on the results of the most recent cost-of-living surveys for group II duty stations, the revised post adjustment multiplier listed in Table 2 is applicable effective 1 August 2020.
